















Climbing Your Stairway to Daylight

Stairwells are notoriously dark because they're often located in the center of the home. For the longest time, this has meant artificial light is needed to fill in the space. VELUX is here to offer another solution: skylights.

Arguably, the stairway is one of the areas in your home where sight is most important. At best, a dark stairwell is an inconvenience and, at worst, a serious hazard. We know kids aren't always the best at slowing down or paying attention, and as we age, our eyes and vision inevitably change, rarely for the better. For your family's safety, light and the ability to see clearly are essential in your stairway. And it's been determined time and again that natural lighting from above is best for visual acuity. That's where your stairway skylights come in.

Often a more cost-effective option, a Sun Tunnel can provide the same bright, natural light as a traditional skylight in a fraction of the space. Or if you need even more light, you can line up multiple Sun Tunnel skylights for consistent lighting up and down your staircase.


Natural light can enrich your health and well-being, and bring a whole lot of positivity.








The VELUX Electric Fresh Air Skylight


Let abundant natural light flow through your small spaces while blocking heat. The venting feature of this electric skylight reduces the need for air conditioning and improves indoor air quality.

The VELUX Manual Fresh Air Skylight


